Dial up the heat ~ mild, warm, hot, burning up, Help I'm on fire!

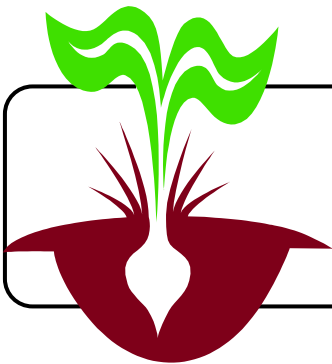
